Mrs. Sophie Clausing

Sophie Clausing, nee Schoenbeck, was born September 12, 1873, in Arlington Heights; was baptized and confirmed in Arlington Heights Lutheran church by Rev. Roeder. She was married to Mr. Charles Clausing, September 4, 1892, in the Arlington Heights St. Peter's Lutheran church by Rev. Roeder. Nine children were of this union; six preceding their parents in death. Mrs. Clausing passed away Sunday evening, November 3, 1935, at her home in Arlington Heights at the age of 62 years, 1 month and 21 days.
