

Patrick C. Dolf, 24, of Schaumburg, died Saturday when his vintage single-engine airplane crashed in a rural Kane County cornfield after taking off from Olson Airport near Elgin. Mr. Dolf had been flying for about five years. He was a self-employed pilot who flew passengers or freight for different companies. He was also a part-time pilot for Scott Aviation. He had previously owned Precision Tile in Bloomingdale. A native of Northbrook, he graduated from Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, Daytona Beach, Fla. He is survived by his parents, John and Annette; a sister, Catherine; and his grandmother, Ann Jummati.
