

Donald J. Fenton. The funeral for Donald J. Fenton, 68, will begin at 10 a.m. Saturday, at Salerno's Rosedale Chapels, 450 W. Lake St. (3/4 mile west of Bloomingdale Road), Roselle, and proceed to St. Isidore Church, Bloomingdale, where a Mass will be celebrated at 11 a.m. He died Saturday, Aug. 30, 2003, in a vehicle accident in Washington State. Mr. Fenton was a pioneer in the automotive fleet industry and a consummate sales professional whose career spanned for decades. He was one of the auto industry's most influential leaders, having got his start at Nickey Chevrolet in Elmhurst. Don built lifelong relationships that resulted in record-setting sales achievements.
