Henry Haberkamp

Henry Haberkamp, passed away at his home on Elmhurst and Central roads, Mt. Prospect, on Saturday afternoon, after being confined to his bed for the past five weeks.

He leaves to mourn his bereaved widow, four children, (2 daughters and 2 sons), 2 daughters in law, 2 sons in law, 8 grandchildren, 1 sister, 3 brothers in law, 2 sisters in law and many relatives and friends.

He was born in Hanover, Germany, November 17, 1863, reaching the age of 77 years, less 1 day.

He was married to Miss Wilhelmina Hulke, on October 29, 1886, at Groene church (now Churchville), Addison; 4 children blessed this union, Louis H., Bertha Behrens, Alma Russel and Edwin.

In August, 1900, Mr. and Mrs. Haberkamp came to make their home in Mt. Prospect, where in 1914 he entered the Florist business in which he continued until 1929 when it was taken over by his son, Edwin.

He was a charter member of St. Pauls Ev. Lutheran Church of Mt. Prospect and served as chairman for many years. He also served this community as a member of the village board for several years.

Services were Tuesday afternoon at 1:30 p. m. at his residence and at 2 p. m. at the Mt. Prospect Lutheran church. Interment was in the Mt. Prospect Lutheran cemetery.
