VolunTeens—Entering grades 7-12 in Fall of 2025

Thank you for your interest in our VolunTeen program. The work of our volunteers is valuable to us as well as to the community. BPL VolunTeens help keep the Youth Services Department neat and organized, prepare program materials, aid in supervising children's programs, and assist with other needed tasks. As a volunteer, you will be subject to the guidelines listed below. Please review these responsibilities and guidelines and make sure that you are willing to comply with them all.

The VolunTeen program is open to students in grades 7 - 12. VolunTeens commit to helping the library once a week for the 9-week summer session beginning **June 2** and ending **August 9.** Volunteer hours are scheduled around teens' availability. VolunTeens can expect to work 10 to 15 volunteer hours during the summer.

The Reading Mentor program is open to students entering 9-12th grade. Reading Mentors will share books and reading activities with new readers in the Read with a Buddy program. Mentors will commit to working 4-6 1-hour shifts on Monday afternoons from 4:30-5:30 from June 16 thru July 21.

Both VolunTeens and Reading Mentors will be given opportunities to help at children's programs in June, July and August. All are invited to help at the Annual Ice Cream Social on Thursday, August 7.

Registration begins April 1. Forms must be received by May 12th. Late forms may not be considered.

All applications will be reviewed and applicants will be notified of their status by May 19th. If you have not heard from Ms. Carol please call 630-924-2744.

ALL Volunteens MUST attend a mandatory informational meeting on one of the following dates/times.

Monday, May 19 - 7:30– 8:30 p.m. **OR** Thursday, May 22 - 4-5 p.m.

All Teen Mentors MUST attend a mandatory informational meeting on June 2 at 6:00 pm or schedule a meeting with Ms. Carol.
